Héloïse's Range



It's important not to write outside this range.

Please also remember:

- 1. Only use the outer ranges very sparingly
- 2. High notes are naturally louder than low notes
- 3. Don't write lots of words, and especially not lots of important ones, in a very high register
- 4. In a vocal piece, it's important to give the singer enough breaks i.e. don't hesitate to write some instrumental only passages

Techniques you might want to explore

- slow glissandi exploring all the possible notes in between each semitone
- broken up words
- rolled «r» or lip trill «brrrr»
- humming

Pitchless Sounds

- unvoiced consonants (R / P / T / K / CH / F/SS) used as percussive sounds
- whispering / speaking
- laughing / crying / gasping
- tongue clicks
- body percussion

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
